

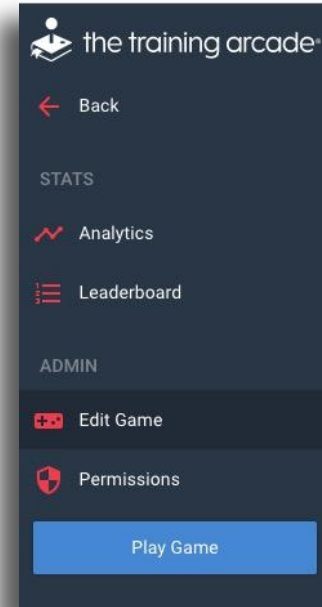
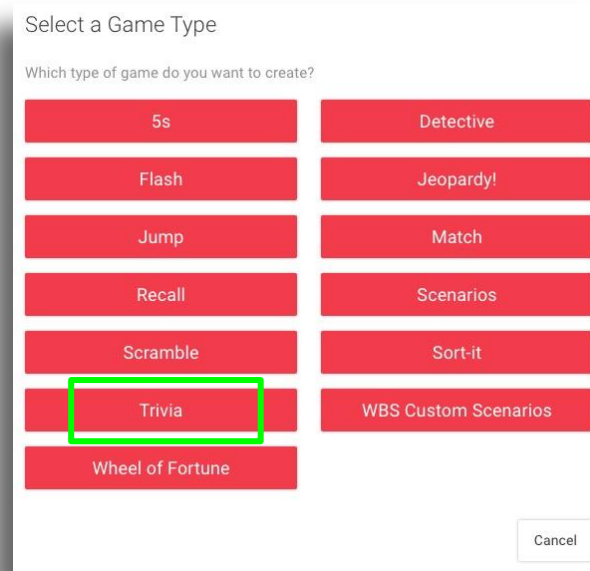
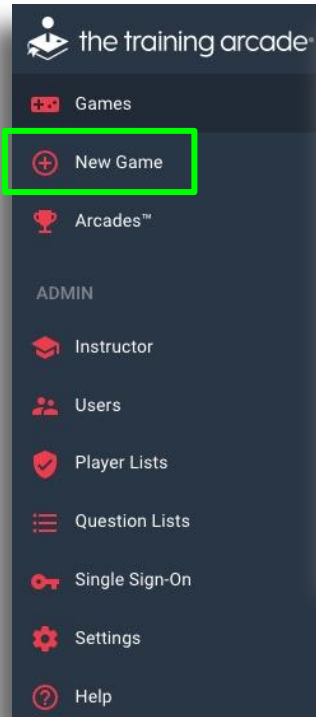
Trivia Creator User Guide



Trivia transforms quizzes and assessments into an engaging, fun and competitive game with points, streaks, leaderboards, and timers. It's ideal for boosting engagement and retention and rewarding learners for fast and correct decision making. Question types include multiple choice, multi-select, image match, text-input, and polling. Players are awarded points based on correct answers and are provided corrective feedback along the way.

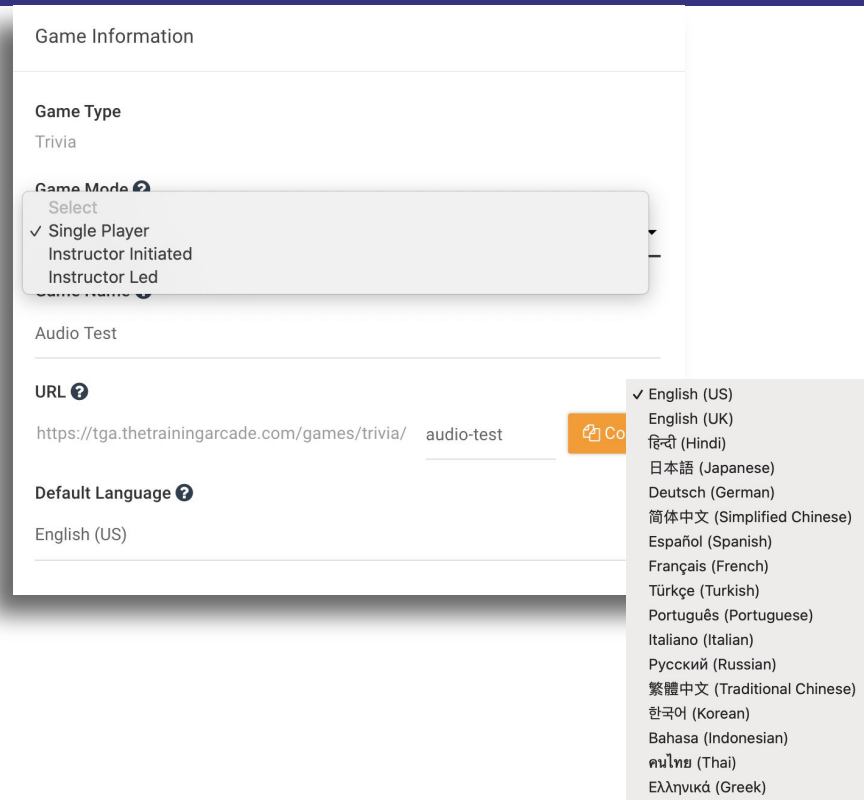
To begin a new game:

popup menu




Set-up your game details under the **“Game Info”** tab

- Determine the **“Game Mode”** (more details on these options later)
 - Single Player

Timer Settings

- Set a **“Default Timer”** per question
 - Enter the amount of time players have to answer each individual question.
 - Using this setting will automatically default each question to the defined amount of time.
 - To change the time on a per question basis, the time can be changed on the question setup page.
- Pass % - Enter an percent of correct answers that players must achieve to pass



Question Settings

- Turn randomize option off if you require your questions are presented in a specific order.
- For example, your questions are progressively harder or if there is a specific learning order for the player.

- Limit the number of questions if you want to keep rounds short
 - If No.....move on, you're all done 😊
 - If Yes....enter the number of questions you want the players to experience in each round.

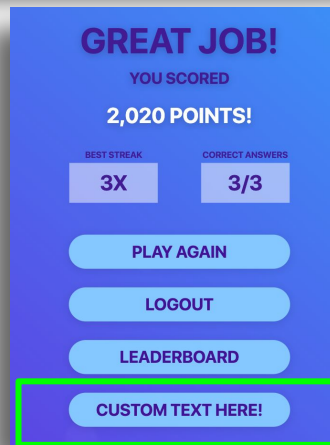





This feature is optional, but an extremely helpful tool to give your players an introduction to the game and material included within it.



Authorization Type:

- **No Authorization:** Games are available to be played by anyone provided with the URL
- **Authorized Player List:** Only players with emails on the list can access the URL
- **SSO:** Once SSO is connected to the account, the SSO becomes the access point and only players listed on the SSO can access the game.





Authorization Type:

- **Authorized Player List (APL):**
 - A player list can be created in excel and loaded into the CMS using an excel CSV file or manual data entry.
 - When an APL is in use, only players on the list can play the game. Anyone not approved to play will be presented with a black screen.



Using SSO - The Training Arcade supports SSO integration via SAML

- You will need to add an idP to your subdomain in order to add SSO to a game.
- Once an idP has been added to the subdomain, the provider will now be visible in this dropdown menu.

* If your IdP is not SAML compliant, we can work to customize the integration on a case by case basis. Please request a client consult in this event.



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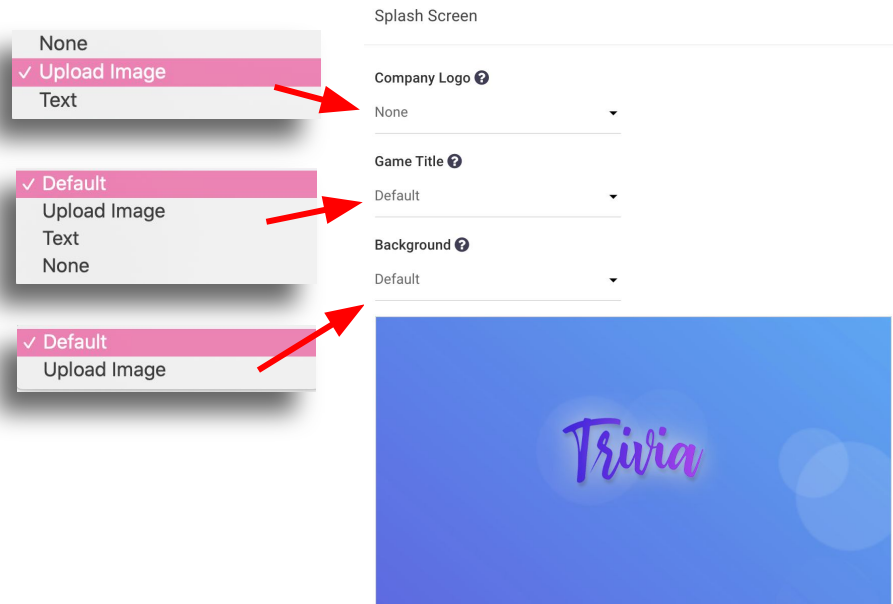
Splash Screen

The Splash Screen is the first screen a player interacts with when they log in to play the game.

There are multiple ways available to a game creator to set up the splash screen.

Locations and defaults are preset and cannot be changed without a custom theme.



Adding a company Privacy Policy is optional and will add a link to the policy on the splash screen of the game.

Company Name The name you wish to be displayed as part of the link.

Question Types

Multiple Choice - Players can choose the correct answer from a given list

Multi Select - Players can choose more than one answer from the given list

Image Match - Players choose the answer from a choice of images

Text Input - Players enter the answer manually, this must match an answer entered by a creator

Poll - Responses are tallied and displayed as a pie chart
